
Dear Director Wray:

Thank you for your April 22, 2022, letter responding to my ongoing concerns with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) confidential human source program and the potential connection with individuals involved in the October 6, 2018, limousine crash in Schoharie, New York in which 20 people were killed. In your letter, you noted that you referred the situation to the FBI Inspection Division for review and that review had begun.

Given the major impact this tragedy had on the lives of my constituents, I am committed to sustained oversight to ensure all questions and concerns are answered, and any necessary reforms are implemented. To that end, I am requesting an anticipated timeline for when this review will be completed. Additionally, I request that you provide a copy of the completed Inspection Division review, including any findings and recommendations.

I appreciate your attention to this request and look forward to receiving information on the Bureau's review.
